



Junior 1000 Ecosse Challenge

Guide to joining the Championship;

(Extract from Championship Regulations)

Junior drivers intending to join the Junior 1000 Ecosse Challenge must qualify to take part as follows;

Pass the Motorsport UK BARS Test.

This can be done at Knockhill Racing Circuit. Call them [01383 723337](tel:01383723337) and purchase a Motorsport UK “Start Rallying” pack. The fee includes a BARS Test, the use of a Knockhill car for the test, first year’s competition licence and the maneuverability test.

Complete a set of Competence Tests

Prior to being permitted to compete in their first Championship event, Junior Drivers will be required to satisfy one of the following two options. The second option is intended to allow new competitors a quicker route into competition as Production Car Autotests are not always available until summer months.

Option 1

- A. Complete a minimum of three Production Car Autotests (known as PCAs) or autosolos organised by a Motorsport UK Recognised Club. At least one of the PCAs or autosolos must be observed by an official appointed by the Organiser. If the Clerk of the Course is satisfied that the Junior Driver has completed the PCA in a competent and safe manner they may sign the Signature Record Card.
- B. Complete a series of maneuverability tests to demonstrate the Junior Driver has a sufficient level of car control. Details of the tests are available from the Championship website. The tests must be observed by an official appointed by the Organiser.

OR;

Option 2

- A. Have had at least two hours one-to-one instruction and assessment carried out at a Motorsport UK approved rally school with a registered BARS instructor. Knockhill is the only BARS Venue in Scotland. A certificate from the rally school confirming that the Junior Driver meets the level of competency required, must be received by the Championship Secretary. The time spent undertaking the Motorsport UK BARS Test does NOT count towards this requirement.
- B. Participate in a driving activity at a Championship Test or Training Day and/or compete in a PCA or autosolo observed by an official appointed by the Organiser.
- C. Complete a series of maneuverability tests to demonstrate the Junior Driver has a sufficient level of car control. Details of the tests are available from the Championship website. The tests must be observed by an official appointed by the Organiser.

Notes;

We have partnered with Knockhill Racing Circuit, who will incorporate the maneuverability test when the Junior driver takes a BARS Test there, and we recommend this, as the Championship doesn’t always have the facility to provide a suitable venue for the maneuverability test.

If the two hours one-to-one tuition at Knockhill option is chosen, the Junior driver must have done **one** of the following three activities prior to the tuition session;

- BARS Test
- an autotest
- Teen Drive session
